WE will work together for the continuation of a faithful evangelical ministry in this church as we sustain its worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines. We will contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, helping the poor, and the spread of the Gospel through all nations.

WHENEVER we do move on from this place, we will unite with another local church as soon as possible, where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word. May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.
