When I was singing in the college choir, we sang a song called, "Be Still and Know." It was a beautiful song to sing with a beautiful melody and harmonies. I really enjoyed singing that song. And, I really enjoyed listening to that song too!

I was always very nervous and stressed before our performances, concerned that I would forget the words of certain songs, or forget the notes I was supposed to sing, or, worse yet, forget the rests that I was supposed to take during the songs. The last thing I wanted to do was to perform an unscheduled solo! But the song that I always looked forward to singing was, "Be Still and Know." Whenever I started in on the words, "Be still and know that I am God," I was strangely calmed and assured that I could get through that performance without taking any more stress upon myself.

As you might already know, those words come from a Psalm that David wrote, Psalm 46. Those particular words are from the first half of verse 10. But do you know the rest of the Psalm? It begins with the words, "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble" and ends with the words, "The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress." Further, right in the middle of the Psalm are the words, "The LORD Almighty is with us; The God of Jacob is our fortress." Hmmm, seems like the writer wants us to know something.

As you read the whole Psalm phrases like, "We will not fear", "God will help", "See what the LORD has done", and "I will be exalted in the earth" confront our faith and trust in God as well as bolster our trust and faith in God. It is a Psalm that is meant to let us know that God is in control; that He is sovereign. That no matter what happens on this planet earth, even if the "mountains fall into the heart of the sea", we do not have to fear. God has us. God is for us. God will help us. God is our fortress.

That little phrase, "Be still, and know that I am God" comes amidst the storms and cataclysms of life. It comes in the midst of earth altering events. The earth is in upheaval, the nations are in uproar, and kingdoms of the world fall. Everything around us is chaos, or seemingly so. Yet, there is a place of stillness. Can you imagine? The whole world is stressing and striving and plotting and planning, yet God says, "be still! Know that I am God." Know that no one else is God. There is none greater or more powerful or more fearsome. Stop stressing about the world, just think about Him! Let His greatness sink in. Let His awesomeness overwhelm you. Just... be... still. Know... that He... is... God.

In His fortress, in His refuge, is the place of stillness. Go there and sing. Go there and find stillness. Go there and know God.
