

If we are all being diligent with safety we will ensure a welcoming space where people of all ages can come and fellowship with other believers and hear of the love and grace of our Lord Jesus.



# Teen Street July 2019


The Young People will be operating the Coffee Machine this morning, providing coffee and hot chocolate. Funds raised will help our young people to attend Teen Street, in July.
