Introduction: Isaiah 2: 1-22 The LORD Alone Shall Be Exalted

- I. The POINT in time and place when the exaltation will take place (Isaiah 2:2). The Latter Days.
 - A. The Latter Days refer to the POURING OUT of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:16-21; Ezekiel 39:29; Zechariah 12:10)
 - B. The Latter Days refer to the PERILS that will come (2 Timothy 3:1-5).
 - C. The Latter Days refer to the PUNISHMENT of the wicked that goes on through the 7-year Tribulation (James 5:1-8).
 - D. The Latter Days refer to the PROMISE of Messiah's return (2 Peter 3:3-9).
 - E. The Latter Days refer to the PLACING of the Temple on the top of the mountains (Micah 4:1-2; Zechariah 14:1, 3-4).

- III. The POSITION it will have in the future (Isaiah 2:2)
- IV. The PEOPLE that will come to it (Isaiah 2:2)
- V. The PRINCIPLES we will learn (Isaiah 2:3)
