I. The Retribution (Isaiah 3:1-4:1)

A. God's judgment on the leaders (Isaiah 3:1-15)

- 1. He will cut off their food and water supplies (Isaiah 3:1)
- 2. All they depended on would be destroyed (Isaiah 3:2-3)
- 3. The foolish would lead instead (3:4)
- 4. Anarchy will prevail (3:5-7)
- 5. The reason for this destruction (3:8-9)
- 6. They will reap what they sow (3:10-11)
- 7. God himself will serve as the great prosecuting attorney (3:12-15)

B. God's judgment on the women (3:16-4:1)

- 1. Their perversions (3:16, 18-23)
 - a. They are haughty and self-centered (3:16)
 - b. They attire themselves in an extravagant way (3:18-23)

 - a. God will make their scalps bald from sores and scabs (3:17)
 - b. He will strip them of their finery and their beauty (3:18, 24-26)
 - c. Seven women will be forced to fight over one man (4:1)
