III. The Punishment of Israel (5:24-30): The Lord's people will suffer punishment for their sinful ways.

- A. The Fire of God will consume them and dead bodies will rot in the streets (5:24,25)
- B. The Lord will bring foreign nations into Jerusalem, resulting in the captivity of the people (5:26-30).
