

Isaiah 11:1-9

Chapter 10 ended with the distress in Israel due to the Assyrians in the near view of prophecy, and the anti-christ in the distant view. There is a coming destruction of Israel that has been decreed. What sets off this decree? It is the signing of the seven-year peace agreement between Israel and the anti-christ (Daniel 9:27).

Verse 1-

- 1. What is the stem of Jesse?
- 2. What is the rod that comes out of the stem of Jesse?
- 3. What is the branch?
- 4. Who is Jesse?

What is the Kingdom?

- Announced in the New Testament by John the Baptist (Matthew 3:2)
- Repent! It's not a command for us to be saved. (Ephesians 2:8,9)
- Don't confuse "kingdom" passages with "Church age" passages.
- Our Christian Living doctrine comes primarily from the epistles (of Paul).

Overview of Israel's history (Acts 13:16-23)

• All of this helps us make sense of Luke 1:32.

Verse 2 -

- Isaiah 42:1
- Isaiah 61:1,2 (Luke 4:16-21)

Verse 3 -

- Delight in the fear of the LORD.
- The Rod of Jesse will Judge with righteousness and uprightness. Based on fact!

Verse 4 -

• The perfect King will rule

Verse 5 -

- **Belt of his loins:** Literally he middle of his waist. Righteous to the core!
- **Belt of his waist:** His faithfulness will be seen and evident to everyone.

Where he is righteous to the core, it will be manifest by his faithfulness in judgment.

Verses 6-8 -

- No aggressive wildlife in the Kingdom.
- Children will live in safety.

Verse 9 -

• There will be no fear of violence (Isaiah 2:4; Isaiah 60:18)
