How to mail letters and Packages:

You are welcome to mail us any letters, cards or packages to Missionary Flights International (MFI) and they will bring it to our local airport every week (usually Tuesday or Thursday). The package will cost an additional \$1.50/lb. once it gets to MFI, we kindly ask that you please contact MFI to make a donation to our account for the amount of the additional cost to send your package. Otherwise, we will be billed for these costs. However, if the package or letter is under 1 pound MFI does not charge us.
