

# UNIFORM SENIORS - Classic

## WHAT IT CONSISTS OF

BB Cap, Cap Badge Metal, BB Navy Shirt, Blue Tie, Battalion Crest, Section Crest, Shoulder Belt, Navy Trousers, Armband, Shoulder Title x2, plain Black Socks, and plain Black Shoes

## WEARING THE SENIORS UNIFORM

**BB Cap**– fits snugly on the head. The metal badge is positioned on the top left side of the cap, 5cm from the front.

**BB Navy Shirt** – should be clean, ironed and tucked into the trousers

**Shoulder Titles** – 1 is sewn centrally on the left sleeve, 5cm down from the shoulder seam. The other is sewn onto the armband. (see badges placement)

**Battalion Crest** – sewn centrally on the right pocket

**Section Crest** – sewn centrally on the left pocket

**Shoulder Belt** – worn under the right epaulette, looped under the belt, buckle to the front

**Blue Tie** – should be clean, ironed

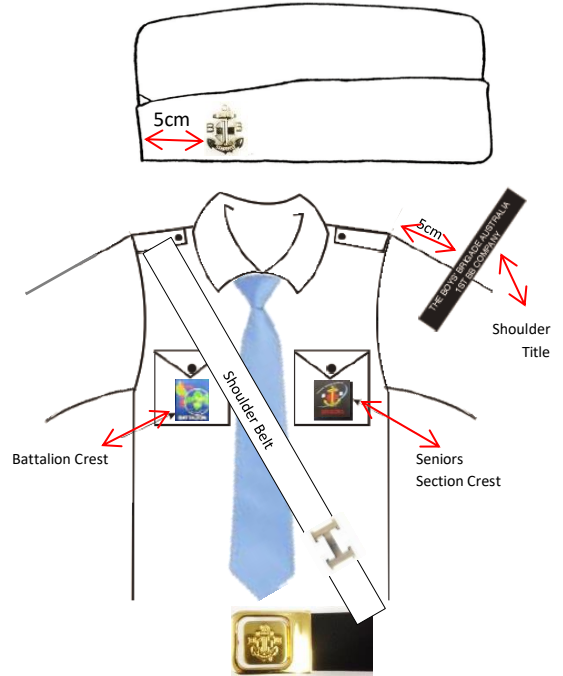
**Armband** - worn on the right arm.

**Trousers Navy** – plain with belt loops should be clean and neatly pressed

**BB Belt** – comes in one size, see your captain to adjust properly

**Socks** – plain black

**Shoes** - black, clean and laces tied neatly. Leather shoes should be polished
