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# WE ARE PREDESTINED!

(ACTS 4:27-28)

- I) What Predestine Means:
  - A) The Greek word proorizō means, to determine or decided beforehand.

#### II) Some Mistakenly Believe

- A) God has already determined who will be saved and lost, regardless of human activity.
- B) God has already determined a specific number of individuals who will go to heaven.
- C) These teaching are not only false, they clearly undermine the Gospel call.

# III) God's Plan of Universal Salvation & Hope was Based Upon Predestination

- A) It began in eternity (2 Tim 1:1, 5-10).
- B) It was first mentioned in the garden (Gen 3:14-15).
- C) It first preached to Abraham (Gal 3:8-9).
- D) The full measure of it's knowledge was hidden as a mystery, but has now been revealed to bring about obedience of faith among all nations (**Eph** 3:1-6; **Rom** 16:25-27).


## IV) Biblical Predestination is about the love of God (Eph 3:14-19).

**T**otal hereditary depravity- Matt. 18:3; 1 Cor. 14:20; Ezk. 18:20; Eccl. 7:29.

**U**nconditional election- Matt 7:13-14; Jn 5:28-29; 2 Pet 1:3-12.

Limited atonement- Jn. 3:16; 1 Tim. 2:3-4; 1 Jn. 2:2.

Irresistible grace- Acts 7:51; 13:44-46.

**P**erseverance of the saints- Gal. 5:1-4; James 5:18-20.

## V) Key Gospel Revelations of Predestination for the Christian

- A) We Were Predestined to Become God's adoptive children (**Eph** 1:3-5).
  - Rom 8:14-15: As God's adopted children, we are led by His Spirit and can confidently cry out,

"Abba Father" as the God's Spirit bears witness with our own, that we are truly God's children.

- 2) **Rom** 8:23: As God's children, "we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies."
- B) We Were Predestined To receive an inheritance (Eph 1:9-12).
  - This inheritance is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading. Not only is it reserved in heaven, but is also being guarded by God's power (1 Pe 1:3-5).
- C) We Were Predestined To become Christlike (Rom 8:29).1) 2 Cor 5:15-17.
- D) We Were Predestined To Be justified and glorified (**Rom** 8:30-31).
