- 1. In August you worked on learning the first nineteen books of the New Testament. Continue with those and add the rest of the New Testament books.
- 2. In Luke's gospel try to identify things you hear in The Divine Service.
- 3. What are the major feasts and festivals that occur in Luke? What were they for?
- 4. Who was Luke? Who was Luke's original audience?
- 5. Look up some extra information outside of the Bible on the different Harods and Pontius Pilate.
