Text: Exodus 20:16

1. What are some ways that you have been guilty of dishonesty recently?
2. What are some ways that you may have been guilty of bearing false witness against someone else?
3. What were the motivations for your dishonesty? (i.e. Why did you lie?)

Apply it to life: What are some steps *you* can take to pursue complete honesty in your life?

Pray about it: Repent of your dishonesty, gossip, or anything that qualifies as bearing false witness. Look to Christ for forgiveness and trust in the grace of the Holy Spirit to enable you to be honest in all areas of your life.

Meditate on it: Exodus 23:1; Proverbs 24:28
