TITLE: Devine Light in a Dark World

TEXT: John 8:12-20


A P P L Y I N G G O D 'S W O R D: Now that you've heard God's Word taught it is time to apply God's truths specifically to your own life (James 1:22). The following steps can help you grow in your sanctification in the Lord.

- 1. What are the theological implications of Jesus' claim to be "the Light of the world" (John 8:12)? What is Jesus claiming about Himself (cf. Exodus 13:21-22 and Isaiah 49:6)? Why does this matter? How does this confession effect your worship of Jesus?
- 2. What is the difference between Jesus being a light versus Him being the Light? How does that difference impact your testimony of Jesus to an unbeliever?
- 3. What does it mean to follow Jesus? Why is following Jesus a mark of saving faith? What is the difference between "following" Jesus and simply "saying" that Jesus is your Savior?
- 4. Meditate and memorize John 8:12, "Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, 'I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."
