January 20-24, 2020 11:45 am

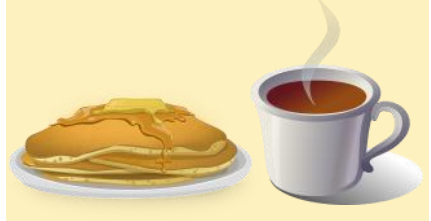
St. Mary's Anglican Church (5120-49 Ave.)

*Starting in May, Mike began treatment for diverticulitis and colitis, but his pain continued. After several months of testing and seeing various doctors, his gallbladder was removed on Oct 3rd.*
