KENJI AND SANDY KONDO OPERATION MOBILIZATION

Dear praying friends,

Thank you for your continuing prayer for my Mom Yoshiko. The reason I have not been on top of my email about her is because Sandy needed **medical attention** besides Shinji & Satoshi. Let's start with Mom.

Yoshiko has been **getting better**. She has been **out of ICU** so now kids are allowed to see her. This coming **Monday**, **Dec 23rd**, she will be **transferred to a hospital** that is specialized in **rehabilitation** so that she can continue to work on rehabilitation over the new years. She **still** relies on a tube for producing **urine**, and her **right arm & leg** are **immobilized** in most functions. Her daily meds are still **fed by a nose tube**.

Now I report about Sandy. First, she had **pneumonia** in November. That time, we still had Mom to help us. 2 weeks after Mom's brain haemorrhage, Sandy couldn't turn her neck, and couldn't open her mouth, and had severe pain—2 days of **no food and bed-ridden in pain**. In the next 2 days, Sandy had series of medical examinations (blood, ultra sound, CT, X-ray, etc) that led to **find large inflammation** in both parotid gland & submandibular gland. Fast forward by 1 week, Sandy is now doing much better. We are **thankful** for local **Christians** who **helped** our family by **cooking** food and **watching kids** while I was busy driving around for visiting Mom, driving for different medical attention for Sandy, Satoshi and Shinji...

Now I don't want you to think that our life was just spent on hospitals. That's far from truth. During this tough time, we are amazed how God used different things and people for His glory.
