

Dear Friends,

February is already here! This year, Lent starts a bit later than it has in the last couple of year. What does that mean? We had a couple of extra weeks in Epiphany that we hear some of the revelations of Jesus that we don't usually hear and that we get to have all kinds of time to start our Spring cleaning. Lent literally means spring season. Traditionally the season of Epiphany would be spent cleaning out the food in your cupboards like yeast and fats with the feasting to use up those ingredients. You may have heard the term Shrove Tuesday. This is the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday. It was the day traditionally to purify and remove meat, fish, eggs, fats, milk and sugar from the house. Many churches will have pancake meals either on Shrove Tuesday or like us, have moved it to the Sunday before Ash Wednesday (Transfiguration Sunday).

This year, on Transfiguration Sunday, we will have our boy and girl scouts help us burn the palm branches from last year so we can use the ashes on Ash Wednesday, we will also have a pancake breakfast as a fundraiser for the youth and we will get ready to start the season of Lent.

As we start to think about the season of Lent, I encourage you to think of this season as a season to take on something new. Think a new spiritual discipline to try for 40 days. This could be reading about our saints, it could be praying the daily offices, it maybe decluttering (40 bags in 40 days from whitehouseblackshutters.com), volunteering at the NEW shelter or writing a letter to someone who has touched your life every day during Lent. We will have a print copy of a Lenten devotional in the narthex and you will also get links emailed to you as well.

However, you mark the season of Lent, I invite you to a time of reflection and learning.
