Primary Responsibilities and Tasks:

- Familiarity with Quickbooks Online is a must.
- Revenue: summarize and record offerings, designated funds and other income sources
- Expenses: pay and record expenses, including payroll
- Record journal entries, as applicable
- Maintain designated funds reconciliation
- Maintain & reconcile petty cash fund
- Prepare monthly financial reports, quarterlies, and annual statements
- Assist Board of Elders and Ministry leaders with Budget prep

Pay and Benefit Structure

- \$20-\$25/hour, depending on experience, 4-6 hours a week.
- Health/dental/vision insurance is not provided for by the church.
- One week of vacation pay (15 hours) per year begins to accrue after 3 months of serving in the position. Sick time per state requirement of 1 hr for every 40 hours worked (approx 20 hr/yr).

They first met in Gibson Hall near the fish hatchery and then moved to the Mercantile Building.
