

Servant Thoughts

And after fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. Matthew 4:2 (ESV)

Look in the Scriptures for significant numbers and the number 40 would be one of those numbers that will jump out at you. It rained for 40 days and 40 nights during the flood. The Israelites spent 40 years in the wilderness. Moses spent 40 days on Mount Sinai meeting with the Lord. During the time of the Judges it speaks of God's people having peace for 40 years between the various judges. I could go on, but I think you can tell it's a significant number.

At the beginning of Jesus' ministry, right after His baptism, He was led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness and endured a time of temptation. As the verse notes above, this lasted 40 days... and he fasted the whole time. During the season of Lent, we observe 40 days also, minus Sundays, which aren't counted in that number 40. That is why we call the Sundays the First Sunday in Lent and not the First Sunday of Lent. So, if you consider doing something special during this season of repentance and reflection... you can if you want, take Sunday off. Giving up chocolate or coffee or Netflix... you can enjoy a cup of coffee or a big brownie or binge a few shows on Sunday and not feel guilty about having not lived up to your commitment.

I share this observation with you not to necessarily encourage you do something special or skip Sunday as a part of some Lenten discipline. Instead I share it with you, so you realize the purpose behind such practices is really about focusing on Jesus and what He did for us. It should not be something that makes you feel guilty. It should be something that makes you feel joyful and more appreciative of all that Jesus did for you. Better to not doing anything at all than to choose to follow some discipline or practice that is going to focus on what you do or don't do.

In other words... if you give up something or take up some special effort during these 40 days of Lent, let it be something that will help you focus on Jesus! In the service and love of Jesus,

This year, Pastor Rob and I have chosen a Lent focus series entitled "Eyes on Jesus".
