Lesson Notes 5 The Name of Son of Man March 8, 2020

Reasons Jesus is called Son of Man:

- 1. It points to His humanity
 - a. That he was born and lived as a common man Luke 9:58;
 - b. That he would be betrayed and die as a man 24:7
 - c. For him to fulfill his Messianic Role, He had to be a man Is. 7:14; 9:6-7; 11:1-10
- 2. It points to His role of suffering and death
 - a. Luke 9:22, 44; 17:22-25; 22:22,48; 24:7;
 - b. As prophesied Is. 53
 - c. Which is a saving role Luke 19:10
- 3. Points to His Role as Prophet
 - a. Like Ezekiel
 - b. Luke 11:30 Compared to Jonah
 - c. 17:26 Compared to Noah
 - d. 18:31 Everything prophesied fulfilled
- 4. Points to His return
 - a. Luke 18:8 To judge faith and justice
 - b. 21:27 Bringing Redemption
- 5. Points to His ruling role Acts 2:22-36
 - a. Luke 5:24 Authority to forgive sins
 - b. 6:5 Lord of the Sabbath
 - c. 22:69 Will be seated at the right hand of the power of God
 - d. Acts 7:56 Standing at right hand of God
 - e. Dan 7:13-14 Son of Man (in Aramaic) Phil. 2:6-11
 - 1) Came before the Ancient of Days
 - 2) Given dominion and glory and a kingdom
 - 3) All peoples, nations, and languages should serve him
 - 4) His dominion is an everlasting dominion which shall never pass away
 - 5) His kingdom is one that shall not be destroyed
- 6. Points to His priestly role Hebrews Chapters 1-2; 4:14-16
 - a. Came as Human representing the Glory of the Father (1:1-3; John 1:1-18)
 - b. Made purification for sins and sat down at the right hand of the Father receiving authority greater than angels (1:1-6)
 - c. Became human so he might become High Priest making atonement for sins (2:9-18)
 - d. Because he was tempted like us, He can help us when we are tempted (2:14-18; 4:14-16)
