Lesson Notes for Lesson 6 "Son of God" March 15, 2020

Sermon Outline

Introduction: Son of God in Luke and Acts:

- 1. Luke Begins and Ends with Stating Jesus is the Son of God
 - Birth of Jesus Foretold (Luke 1:26-36 v. 32, Son of the Most High, v. 35 the Son of God)
 - Jesus on Trial (Luke 22:66-23:3, Christ, Son of Man, Son of God, King of Jews)
 - In between Satan tempts him with, "If you are the Son of God" 4:3, 9 and demons acknowledge him as Son of God 4:41
- 2. In Acts, Saul of Tarsus (Paul) begins preaching immediately after his conversion that Jesus is the Son of God (Acts 9:20). What a turnaround for one who persecuted the believers for blaspheming God!

Question: How can there be only one God and there be a Son of God?

The problem for devoted Jewish leaders to believe in Jesus as the Son of God was the Old Testament teaching of God Himself!

- 1. Ex. 3:11-15 I AM the LORD the God of your fathers (one and only true God)
- 2. Deut. 5:6-11 (Ten Commandments) Only one God have no other gods before me
- 3. Deut. 6:4 (Shema) "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one."
- 4. But John's Gospel begins with a strange teaching of one that was with God and was God! (John 1:1-18). And ends with Him being the Son of God (John 20:30-31). And in between:
 - 1) John gives 8 signs to help us believe in the Son of God:
 - i. Water to Wine (2)
 - ii. Healing Official's Son (4)
 - iii. Healing Lame Man (5)
 - iv. Feeding 5000 (6)
 - v. Walking on Water (6)
 - vi. Healing Blind Man (9)
 - vii. Resurrection of Lazarus (11)
 - viii. Jesus' Resurrection (20)
 - 2) Jesus says of Himself using the expression of God, "I AM":
 - i. Bread of Life (6:35-58)
 - ii. Light of the World (8:12; 9:5)
 - iii. Door of the Sheepfold (10:7)
 - iv. Good Shepherd (10:11,14)
 - v. Resurrection and Life (11:25)
 - vi. Way, Truth and Life (14:6)

- vii. True Vine 15:1)
- viii. Concluding that as the I AM before Abraham, He must be God's Son 8:28, 42-59.

Conclusion: John 20:30-31 We must believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God to have life in His name!
