Here are five things you should know about the AAEO:

- I. The offering's namesake, Annie Armstrong (1850-1938), was born in Baltimore at a time when women had little voice. Yet, she challenged pastors and churches to take action in their communities and rallied vital support for missionaries. Annie was recognized as a national Southern Baptist trailblazer for her visionary leadership in missions.
- 2. More than \$1 billion has been given to the AAEO since the offering began in 1895. This past year, the AAEO receipts were \$61.6 million—the highest to date.
- 3. The AAEO is 49% of NAMB's annual budget. Every gift goes to train, resource and send thousands of missionaries in church planting and compassion ministries.
- 4. The offering supports North American missions work where approximately 363 million people live, and a projected 75% of those people do not have a personal relationship with Christ.
- 5. Depending on a missionary's role, the offering may provide financial support, housing, ministry equipment, rent for worship facilities, emergency assistance, encouragement gifts, Bibles and curriculum and other resources.
