A skateboard Coulter uses to move across the stage during his programs has become his trademark.

In 1966, Coulter was born with 28 broken bones because of Osteogenesis imperfecta, a genetic disorder also known as brittle bone disease.

His odds of survival were small, but Coulter beat the odds and has since built his life and career around ministering to and encouraging others as they face obstacles in their lives.

"I can't walk, so I preach a constant message that people can go through anything that comes in their way if they have the Lord on their side," Coulter said. "They can get through it."

"I'd just like to invite everybody out," he said. "I'm looking forward to a good time."
