



## LESSON 10: JESUS HEALS A BLEEDING WOMAN AND RESTORES A GIRL TO LIFE

### GAME: TANGLED KNOT

#### SUPPLIES

- Upbeat music (optional)
- Music player (optional)

Jairus and the sick woman in the crowd had problems they couldn't fix on their own. That's why they came to Jesus. Let's see what it's like to face a problem that's hard to fix on our own.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Choose someone in your family to be the "Untangler." Have the rest form a knot with others by getting in a huddle and joining hands with two different persons across from them.

The Untangler will give directions to help untangle the knot. Follow the Untangler's directions without letting go of other people's hands. Untangler gives directions to help untangle the knot. After two minutes, have someone in the knot change places with the Untangler and continue the game. If the Untangler is able to untangle the knot, choose a new Untangler and form a new knot.

How did you feel when a direction you gave to untangle the knot didn't work? How did you feel when the Untangler helped you get untangled in a way you didn't think would work? Like in our game, we don't always know how to fix the problems we face—especially when we're sick or someone we know is sick. But Jesus has ways of fixing those problems because Jesus has power over sickness and death.
