

## PALM SUNDAY: JESUS' TRIUMPHANT ENTRY

**CRAFT: BOWL & CUP DONKEYS** 

## **SUPPLIES**

- 1 Paper bowl
- 1 3-ounce paper cup
- 1 Craft stick
- Donkey handout
- Jesus and donkey
- Gray or brown markers or washable paint
- Paintbrushes (optional)
- Black, gray, or brown yarn
- Crayons
- Tape
- Glue dots
- Safety scissors



When Jesus entered Jerusalem, he rode on a donkey instead of a fancy horse. People lined the streets praising Jesus because Jesus is the King! Let's make a donkey craft to remember our Bible story.

## **INSTRUCTIONS – GET YOUR PARENT'S HELP**

Cut a small slit the width of the craft stick just below the lip of each cup.

Then turn bowl over and cut the same size slit near the curve at the bottom of the bowl.

Cut several 3-inch lengths of yarn. Cut the Jesus figure from the "Jesus and Donkey" handout.

Paint or color the craft stick and the outside of the bowl and cup brown or gray.

Cut out the "Donkey" handout.

Slide the craft stick through the slits in the bowl and cup and tape the craft stick to the inside of each.

Then, tape the lip of the colored cup on the donkey's face (the cup will become the donkey's nose).

Finally, glue several pieces of yarn to the other side of the bowl as the donkey's tail.

When you have finished making the craft, put your Jesus figure on the back of the donkey.

You can push the donkeys across the table and shout, "Hosanna to the King!"
