

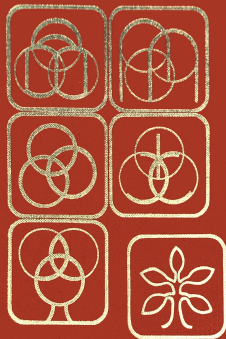

6 Is the Bible sometimes hard to understand?

The Bible is sometimes hard to understand, but it is clear enough to those who use it correctly.

7 How should you correctly use the Bible?

I should regularly read and hear it thoughtfully, asking the Holy Spirit to instruct me so that I can believe it and live according to its teaching.

John 16:13a - *But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth.* **Luke 11:28** - *Blessed ... are those who hear the word of God and obey it.*

1 Corinthians 2:14 - *The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned.*
