Dear Trinity Church Family,

We have now navigated the first few weeks of this interesting season of social distancing, and it looks as if we will continue to do so for the foreseeable future. I want to thank all of our church and childcare staff, our leadership, volunteers, and our whole church family for working together to adapt and adjust frequently! *I have been so inspired by our congregation's response of faith, hope, and love in these uncertain times.* Every week, I hear new stories of how different church members have been spurred on "toward love and good deeds" and found creative ways to connect and "meet together" to *be* the church. ## HOLY WEEK APRIL 6<sup>TH</sup> – 12<sup>TH</sup>, 2020

- WEDNESDAY NIGHT PRAYER VIGIL: We will have a special Prayer Vigil for Holy Week with the same time and format—Wednesday at 6:30pm with a written Prayer Guide and Facebook Live video.
- **GOOD FRIDAY 24 HOUR PRAYER**: To culminate our Lenten season of "A Life of Prayer," we had planned to launch our church Prayer Room with a 24-Hour Prayer vigil where members could sign up for different shifts around the clock. Even though we will have to wait to open the Prayer Room, we can still take our posts to pray intently for a full day—and now this is more relevant than we could have imagined. We broke the day into half-hour increments from 7am Friday to 7am Saturday, and you can sign up for as many half-hour blocks throughout the day as you want. - <u>ACTIVATE EGG-CELLENT EASTER PARTY</u>: We are all disappointed not to be able to have our Easter Egg community outreach, but Activate is proving a fun family activity you can do from home until our doors open again! You'll receive a small package in the mail with several items and instructions that will go along with a video activity/lesson from Miss Emily.
- **COMMUNITY EASTER SUNRISE ON THE PORCH**: Maybe you've seen the news stories about communities like Bloomsburg creating Facebook groups inviting everyone to venture onto their porch to dance and sing at the same time—the Bloomsburg group reached 30,000 members and drew headlines around the country! We thought it would be great to apply this concept to worship, so on Easter Sunday, we're inviting our entire community (and anyone who wants to join anywhere else!) to go outside to their porch for an Easter Sunrise worship time. We'll provide a simple outline with Scripture, prayer, and a Song that can be used by Christians from any church background and hopefully will catch on for our whole community! - HOUSE CHURCH: We will also continue the House Church format for Easter, with a special program to help your family celebrate the Resurrection!

- <u>SUNDAY HOUSE CHURCH</u>: House Church is continuing! We'll send out the Message Video & House Church Guide each Friday so you can worship, pray, learn and connect as the church each Sunday. After Easter, we start a new 8-week series on Philippians! We'll be living out our church vision by *immersing ourselves in God's Word, in God's Presence, and in God's people.* (See below)
- **DAILY TEXT**: Each week, we'll share a guide breaking down Philippians into several verses per day, with questions to reflect and pray through the text. By the end of the 8 weeks, we will read and pray through the entire book together.
- DISCIPLESHIP BANDS: Our goal in the coming months and years is to expand the relational discipleship programs of our church (classes, small groups, etc.) "Discipleship bands" are a transformative, historic way Christians have connected in groups of 3 to 5 for the simple purpose of prayer, encouragement, and accountability. This season of "lockdown" is a great time to experiment with this powerful tool of discipleship!
