WE ARE STILL THE CHURCH - We are still involved in missions:

"Night of 100 Casseroles": was a BIG Success! 65 families were served!

Basic Needs Mission: As an update to our ministry, we are continuing to help provide food for the community through the Thursday "**drive-through**" at the **Family Center**. Many have come faithfully to serve our effort. The need for new clients is growing, while the regular clients have slacked off a bit. No one in town can figure this out. The same is happening at the other food pantries as well.

Other opportunities have opened up. Basic Needs workers are helping with the **TAFB food/produce give away on the third Thursday of the month** as always, but we are also helping with the weekly food distribution at Chamberlain Elementary whenever possible.

Basic Needs has some very dedicated workers as you know, but two more of our number have been dealing with health issues since the shelter-in phase began. **Kim O'Dea**, a faithful worker, had a stroke about three weeks ago. This past Friday I received a call from her daughter asking if we could help prepare the home for Kim's return. (*Cleaning, making sure of handicap accessibility, etc.*) Two days were spent helping. Kim is now home and Basic Needs workers and church members have volunteered to keep helping as needed.

Another Basic Needs worker, **Gloria Scott**, had an arteriogram at Texas Southwest Hospital on May 1st. Based Needs provided transportation for her.

I am certain most members know that only the Food Pantry portion of Basic Needs is still in operation. The other portion was deemed unessential to the livelihood of the community we serve. That doesn't mean we can't help where needed from the clothing/furniture side, but we are unable to work that side as the 6' spacing for safety isn't feasible in that operation. We are continuing to help with pledge letters when possible as customers come to get food. The need is great and continues to grow in this respect.
