## Scripture Reading 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1 (CSB)

<sup>23</sup> "Everything is permissible," but not everything is beneficial. "Everything is permissible," but not everything builds up.

<sup>24</sup> No one is to seek his own good, but the good of the other person.

 $^{\rm 25}$  Eat everything that is sold in the meat market, without raising questions for the sake of conscience,

<sup>26</sup> since the earth is the Lord's, and all that is in it.

<sup>27</sup> If any of the unbelievers invites you over and you want to go, eat everything that is set before you, without raising questions for the sake of conscience.

<sup>28</sup> But if someone says to you, "This is food from a sacrifice," do not eat it, out of consideration for the one who told you, and for the sake of conscience.

<sup>29</sup> I do not mean your own conscience, but the other person's. For why is my freedom judged by another person's conscience?

<sup>30</sup> If I partake with thanksgiving, why am I criticized because of something for which I give thanks?

<sup>31</sup>So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God.

<sup>32</sup> Give no offense to Jews or Greeks or the church of God,

<sup>33</sup> just as I also try to please everyone in everything, not seeking my own benefit, but the benefit of many, so that they may be saved.

<sup>1</sup> Imitate me, as I also imitate Christ.
