Palm Sunday — April 5

Maundy Thursday — April 9

"Maundy" is Latin for "commandment" and it reminds us of the "new command" Jesus gave to His disciples in the Upper Room to "love one another." A short video will be available to help us remember Christ's love as He instituted what we now call "communion."

Good Friday — April 10

The classic hymn, "The Old Rugged Cross," puts it well:

- For 'twas on that old cross Jesus suffered and died,

To pardon and sanctify me.

Another short video will be available as we remember Christ's sacrificial death on the cross.

Easter Sunday – April 12

Even if we are not able to meet together, the reality of an empty tomb still is the defining moment of all human history. Join with us online as we celebrate the reality of the resurrection power that raised Jesus from the dead and is available to us today!


ONLINE — You now can give online through our church website: www.hoodview.church — click on the "Giving" tab

DROP OFF — A mail slot is available at the church office, next to the office door. Donations and other items can be dropped through the slot.


PICK UP — Call the office (503-981-1660) and we can make arrangements to pick up your donation, if needed.

The old philosophical question that asks, "If a tree falls in a forest and no one is around to hear it, does it make a sound?" reminds me of a similar question: "If we can't meet together on Easter, does Easter still happen?" Let me answer that question: YES! Easter is not simply a day on the Christian calendar, but it is the pivotal event of all history. It is the day that Jesus rose from the dead, conquering sin and death for all who trust in Him as Savior. It is the day that provides us the means to receive a whole new way of looking at life. Though we still may have trouble and suffering in this life here on earth, because Christ's death on the cross was followed by His resurrection, we have an assurance that these temporary sufferings are just that—temporary. We also know that greater things await us. Consider these truths from God's Word:

In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade (1 Peter 1:3-4 NIV).

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you (Romans 8:11 NIV).

While we may not be able to experience our "normal schedule" of events this Easter, the reality of Easter remains as bedrock and solid as ever. The first Sunday back after the "stay at home" order is lifted, we will have an "Easter service" and celebrate together this reality that Jesus is alive and that He reigns today and forevermore!
