Matthew 6:26 NLT. *Look at the birds. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren't you far more valuable to him than they are?*

Matthew 6:28–29 The Living Bible. *"And why worry about your clothes? Look at the field lilies! They don't worry about theirs." ²⁹ Yet King Solomon in all his glory was not clothed as beautifully as they.*

Matthew 6:31–33 NLT. *"So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?'"³² These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs.³³ Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.*

1 Peter 5:7 NLT *Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.*

Matthew 6:32 NLT *These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs.*

Philippians 4:6–7 The Living Bible. *Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything; tell God your needs, and don't forget to thank him for his answers.⁷ If you do this, you will*

experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will keep your thoughts and your hearts quiet and at rest as you trust in Christ Jesus.

4. Trust God _____

Matthew 6:34 NCV *So don't worry about tomorrow, because tomorrow will have its own worries. Each day has enough trouble of its own.*

Matthew 6:34 The Message. *"Give your entire attention to what God is doing right now, and don't get worked up about what may or may not happen tomorrow. God will help you deal with whatever hard things come up when the time comes.*

Isaiah 58:7–11 GNB. *Share your food with the hungry and open your homes to the homeless poor. Give clothes to those who have nothing to wear, and do not refuse to help your own relatives. ⁸ "Then my favor will shine on you like the morning sun, and your wounds will be quickly healed. I will always be with you to save you; my presence will protect you on every side. ⁹ When you pray, I will answer you. When you call to me, I will respond. "If you put an end to oppression, to every gesture of contempt, and to every evil word; ¹⁰ if you give food to the hungry and satisfy those who are in need, then the darkness around you will turn to the brightness of noon. ¹¹ And I will always guide you and satisfy you with good things. I will keep you strong and well. You will be like a garden that has plenty of water, like a spring of water that never runs dry.*
