Text: Hebrews 11:8-12

Title: The Exemplary Faith of Sarah

Introduction

- I. God's People in Marriage: Abraham and Sarah
 - A. Sarah's faith is celebrated.
 - B. Sarah's faith is celebrated even when she was severely shaken!
 - C. Sarah's faith was strengthened: "By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed..."
- II. Faith may be severely shaken and tossed by difficulties which seem like unsurmountable roadblocks to God's promise, yet it will overcome all.
 - A. Where do these degrees of weakness and failures in faith come from?
 - B. What are we told about what Sarah obtained by faith?
- III. What was the nature of Sarah's faith by which she obtained this mercy?
 - A. What act is ascribed to Sarah?
 - B. What is the specific object of Sarah's faith?
- IV. Helps for a Mother's faith
 - A. The first object of faith in God's promises is God Himself who has promised.
 - B. We must see every promise of God with this truth attached: "Is anything too hard for the Lord?"
