## WE ARE STILL THE CHURCH - We are still involved in missions:

"Night of 100 Casseroles": was a BIG Success! 65 families were served! Our next Night of 100 Casseroles will be Thursday, 5/28/2020, and will repeat on the 4th Thursday of each month. Drop off of casseroles will be 4:00 to 5:00 at the Family Center. Distribution is from 5:00 until 7:00 (or when the food is all gone!)

**Prison Ministry "For Such A Time As This":** To my Graham Street Church Family, I would like to say "thank you" for supporting the Jail and Prison Ministry. You are to be commended for your love, compassion and generous gifts which are making this Ministry possible.

In addition to our Prison Ministry here, we are supporting a Prison Ministry in Zimbabwe where New Life Behavior curriculum is being taught. There are fourteen courses designed to help individuals to be reconciled to God, family, and society. The Bible is used as the guide to teach desired changes in thinking, attitudes and behaviors. The curriculum is approved by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

We are blessed to be part of a congregation whose leadership saw the need for Celebrate Recovery in our community. In addition to the weekly meetings at the Family Center, we started Celebrate Recovery classes at the local jail each week for men and women. As interest in studying the Bible grew, we introduced New Life Behavior Courses. We could never have imagined that from this beginning, we would be mailing these "little brown leather Bibles" and New Life Behavior Courses to men and women all over the states of Texas and Arkansas, as well as other states as far off as Wisconsin.

Currently, we have mailed a total of 800 Bibles and are sharing New Life Behavior lessons with as many as 300 men and women. This number grows daily as we receive requests for Bibles and the New Life Behavior Courses. For those who are participating in this Ministry, we are blessed and would like to visit with any of you who may be praying to God to "enlarge your territory". You never know where His Spirit especially when we are living in "such a time as this".
