

Talking about God's Ten Commandments *

23 What is the central teaching of the law?

The central teaching of the law is to love God and my neighbor.

Matthew 27:37-40 - Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all you heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. All the Law and the Prophets hang on these tow commandments."

24 What two things do you need to remember as you study each commandment?

In each commandment I must remember the evil which God forbids me to do and the good which He requires.

25 What did God say before He gave the Ten Commandments to Moses?

He said, "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery" (Exodus 20:2).

26 Why was this introduction given?

It was given to show the people that God loved His people and that He acted to help them in a particular time and place and that His action toward them was one of kindness.
