

Re: Upcoming Worship

Dear FPC Family,

Grace and peace to each of you. I pray you all are well in this crazy time we are living in. I wanted to write and update you on the actions of the Session in regards to our corporate worship. A unanimous vote was taken at a May 12<sup>th</sup> called meeting for June 7, 2020, to be our "hope for" date of once again gathering in our sanctuary together. What this means is that the sanctuary will be open for worship on that date at 10:30 a.m. as long as nothing changes with regards to the virus and our community. We will, of course, stress a social distance (of at least 6 feet) be kept between all worshippers at all times. This means an enormous amount of flexibility is needed and required by all of us---we may not be able to sit in our usual spots. During the first few weeks of being back together we will highly encourage masks be worn understanding this simple action is about protecting the other. We will have a few new masks available made by our own Marilyn Bedsworth. We will also ask that everyone use the provided hand sanitizer prior to entering the sanctuary and refrain from our usual handshakes and hugs. Regarding the cleanliness of the church building; prior to June 7<sup>th</sup>, we are instructing our cleaning company to thoroughly sanitize all surfaces paying particular attention to the sanctuary, i.e.-the pews, door handles, etc.

Other changes to Sunday morning will include:

- 1. No Sunday School (until further notice)---Sunday school lessons will continue to be emailed and available at firstprescornelia.org/resources
- 2. Weekly offerings may be left in the offering plate as you enter or exit the sanctuary OR be made online at firstprescornelia.org/give. We will NOT be passing an offering plate around. Please do continue to make your offerings.

This has been a difficult decision for the Session for the past few months as to when to "open back up" the church. We, respectfully, recognize many in our congregation may not feel comfortable to return for quite some time. This is certainly ok and a call to us all to continue to pray for each other and to make sure we all stay connected. Rest assured, we will continue to livestream our Sunday worship services as well as posting a link on the church website (www.firstprescornelia.org). I know we all long for the day when the sanctuary is filled, once again, with the songs of our praise and worship to our Lord. Until then, please join me in continuing to pray for our church, our community, and our world.

I want each of you to know how much you are loved and missed. I feel it the greatest honor to be called your pastor. Please do not hesitate to call me with any questions or concerns.

May the grace of our Lord, the love of God, and the communion of the Spirit be with us all.
