CRAFT: ARMOR RULES!

SUPPLIES

- 2 8½x11 sheets of card stock
- 2 Thin ribbon cut into approximately 15-inch lengths
- Craft supplies, such as colored tissue-paper squares, stickers, foam shapes, crayons, markers, and felt scraps
- White glue
- Scissors
- Hole punch



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Line both sheets of paper and punch 2 holes in both sheets of card stock.
2. While they are both lined up, insert your ribbon through holes of both sheets and tie a knot on the ribbon to seal it.
3. Decorate the front side of your shield.
