

Opening of Church Building

As **Hebrews 10:24-25** say, “²⁴ And let us consider how we spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching.” **It has been our desire to submit to governing authorities as we continue to worship and come around the Word as best we were able. Given the clear mandate from the President we now feel it is appropriate to begin to resume meeting for worship with modifications to minimize risks, exercising due caution and the right to gather.** As we start the reopening process, we need to remember that people have different feelings about the risk and seriousness of this situation. We should be respectful of differences, remember that we have the love of Jesus in common. As we would love to have everyone attend, we know that some people are not going to, and we respect that. Every attempt will be made to make the church building as safe as we can, we would like you to do your part as well. By coming to the church building, you agree to assume all the risks of attendance and participation for you and your family.

Guideline/Recommendations for the Church Body

- We will not begin Sunday School until further notice
- Be aware of people’s feelings about personal space and please practice social distancing
- If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, then you should
- If you or a member of your family has been sick recently then we recommend that you do not attend
- If you or a family member are showing any symptoms of being ill then we recommend that you do not attend
- Hand sanitizer will be available in numerous locations around the church
- Church will be thoroughly cleaned after each service

As we progress through this process, we know that things aren’t going to be perfect and things could change from week to week. Please be patient with us and the difficult decisions we try to make. Pastor Kevin, Haley and Ron will be also continuing to video record the messages for those that cannot attend. The only change is that it will **NOT** be available on Sunday Morning, it will be taped live Sunday morning and available Sunday night. **Proverbs 3:5** reminds us to “⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;”
