and uphold me with a willing spirit.**

**Then I will teach transgressors your ways,
and sinners will return to you.**

**Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God,
O God of my salvation,
and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.**

and my mouth will declare your praise.**

**For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it;
you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.**

**The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit;
a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.**
