

## **Resuming In-Person Worship Westminster Presbyterian Church**

The Session has authorized the resumption of in-person morning worship services in the sanctuary beginning **June 7, AD 2020**, pending any further developments.

### **Regarding Individuals Attending:**

1. Individuals who are part of at-risk health groups (those who are immunocompromised, have co-morbidities - such as hypertension, diabetes, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, cardiovascular disease, and cerebrovascular disease, or very elderly) are encouraged to continue making use of the live-stream and not attend in person. If you have respiratory infection, cough, fever, have been exposed to or are under investigation for COVID19 please make use of the live-stream and do not attend in person.
2. Parents are encouraged to use good judgment in bringing young children.
3. The nursery will remain closed at this time.
4. Please wear a mask.

### **Regarding Entering and Exiting:**

1. Please maintain social distancing while entering and exiting the sanctuary.
2. Please use hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the sanctuary.

### **Regarding Seating in the Sanctuary:**

1. Select an available seat (blue) as diagramed below while maintaining social distancing. Families which are already together may sit together.
2. Please don't be offended if you are asked to move to ensure proper social distancing. We are trying to be safe and accommodating for all.
3. Deacon ushers are available to assist you in finding a seat.
4. Tithes and Offerings may be given at the collection points (stars) on either side of the front and rear of the sanctuary as offering plates will not be passed.

**You should also know:**

1. Bulletins will have the hymns we will use in worship. Our pew Bibles and Hymnals will not be available at this time.
2. Hand sanitizer has been placed strategically throughout the building.
3. Communion will be suspended for the time being.
4. This announcement is for the resuming of morning worship and not evening worship and Sunday School at this time.
