GUIDELINES

1. **STAY IN.** Please remain in your vehicle at ALL times. If you need assistance of any kind, look for someone in a blue Trinity shirt and get their attention.

2. **STAY PUT.** Parking attendants will be aiding in the parking of cars prior to service as well as dismissing cars at the end of service. Please do not leave your parked spot once you are in place (barring any extreme emergencies)

3.**TURN OFF.** Please turn your car engine off for safety purposes. This prevents any accidental vehicle movement as well as exhaust fumes from hindering the neighboring cars.

4. **WINDOWS.** You may choose to have your car windows up or down. Sound for the service will be broadcasted over the radio as well as speakers in the parking lot.

5. **MASKS.** Wearing a mask is optional, but strongly recommended as you may want one if you have your windows down.

6. **BATHROOMS.** Facilities will NOT be available (barring any extreme emergencies) so please plan accordingly!

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- TIME. Services begin at 9am and 11am, parking lot will open at 830am and 1030am. Please be prepared to wait in line on the way in and the way out. Some parking spots will need to be backed into.
- AUDIO. Visibility won't be perfect, but you will be able to hear! Sound will come through FM radio and an outdoor sound system.
- **SERVICES.** Worship services will be about 45 mins. with a small team helping to lead music, prayer, and a message by Pastor David.
- **BULLETINS.** Bulletins will be available by Friday online to print or at the entrance. We'll also have kids' packets at the entrance.
- **OFFERING.** You can use our online giving as always, or drop your offering in the boxes with our volunteers as you exit the lot.
- **RESTROOMS**. Unfortunately restrooms will not be available at this time, except for emergencies.
- **PROBLEMS.** If you have a problem and need to exit your vehicle, there will be a hospitality table at the Office Entrance to help.
