 Areas will be marked as a reminder.
- As you enter your temperature will be taken.
- You will be encouraged to wear a mask. We will have some available, but please bring your own if you have one. Remember, wearing a mask is your way of helping your fellow church members be safe.
- We will meet in the fellowship hall.
- There will be volunteers to help your family sit together but have social distancing
 as required. We request you sit front to back and if possible stay in your seats.
 We will exit from rear to front, but you may leave through any of the three doors
 in the fellowship hall. This is the only area that will be open.
- Restrooms in the fellowship hall will be available.
- The collection plate or buckets will be at the entrance to the fellowship hall.
- There will be hand sanitizer freely available also.
- There will be no coffee or donuts available.
- There will be no other services on Sunday.
- There will be no nursery or children's church at this time. We feel for the safety of the children they should stay with their parents in the worship service. It will be a joy to hear their voices and see their smiles as we worship together.
- Sunday school will continue to meet with conference calls.
- On Wednesday night we will continue to meet in the parking lot or online at this time
