



Drive-In Church Guidelines For Participants

Hello! We are SO GLAD you are here for worship!

This is the list of guidelines we will be following for our Drive-In Church service. Please let us know if you have any questions.

1. **STAY IN...** Please remain in your vehicle at ALL times. If you need assistance of any kind, look for someone in a blue Trinity shirt and get their attention.
2. **STAY PUT...** Parking attendants will be aiding in the parking of cars prior to service as well as dismissing cars at the end of service. Please do not leave your parked spot once you are in place (barring any extreme emergencies)
3. **TURN OFF...** Please turn your car engine off for safety purposes. This prevents any accidental vehicle movement as well as exhaust fumes from hindering the neighboring cars.
4. **WINDOWS...**We encourage you to have your windows down. Sound for the service will be broadcasted over the radio (**88.3 FM**) as well as speakers in the parking lot.
5. **MASKS...** Wearing a mask is optional, but recommended as you may want one if you have your windows down.
6. **BATHROOMS...** Bathrooms will NOT be available (barring any extreme emergencies) so please plan accordingly!
7. **PROBLEMS...** If you have a problem and need to exit your vehicle, there will be a hospitality table at the Office Entrance to help.

***Please Note:** As with all guidelines and policies in this time, please be aware and prepared that things may change at any time, allowing us to be either less restrictive or causing us to need to be more restrictive at future services. Thank you SO MUCH for understanding!
