Text: Romans 1:16,17 Title: I Believe: What is saving faith?

Introduction

I. What saving faith is NOT

- A. Faith is not a vague, general notion of being religious.
- B. Faith is not simply and only to profess a religion
- C. Faith is not simply to profess formally that you are a Christian and become attached by tradition or family ties to a church.
- D. Faith is not to simply profess the 'historical faith.'
- E. Faith is not a 'temporary faith.'

II. What is saving faith?

- A. Saving Faith is a certain knowledge whereby the believer holds for truth all that God has revealed to us in His Word.
- B. Saving faith has an Object
- C. Saving faith is the gift of God's grace by the powerful work of the Holy Spirit.
