Welcome Back Inside the Building

After much prayer, research and discussion, the committee has come up with several guidelines that we feel are important for our congregation and to also meet CDC and state guidelines. Most important is for everyone to feel comfortable and safe. Remember social distancing: **NO HUGGING, SHAKING HANDS OR TOUCHING.** If you are sick or feel uneasy about being in a crowd under these guidelines, feel free to stay home. You can continue to worship while listening on Facebook or YouTube as those tapings will continue.

- We ask for everyone to enter through the doors under the covered awning. Please observe the six-foot distancing and stay with your family as you come in. Areas will be marked as a reminder.
- As you enter your temperature will be taken.
- You will be encouraged to wear a mask. We will have some available, but please bring your own if you have one. Remember, wearing a mask is your way of helping your fellow church members be safe.
- We will meet in the fellowship hall.
- There will be volunteers to help your family sit together but have social distancing as required. We request you sit front to back and if possible stay in your seats. We will exit from rear to front, but you may leave through any of the three doors in the fellowship hall. This is the only area that will be open.
- Restrooms in the fellowship hall will be available.
- The collection plate or buckets will be at the entrance to the fellowship hall.
- There will be hand sanitizer freely available also.
- There will be no coffee or donuts available.
- There will be no other services on Sunday.
- There will be no nursery or children's church at this time. We feel for the safety of the children they should stay with their parents in the worship service. It will be a joy to hear their voices and see their smiles as we worship together.
- Sunday school will continue to meet with conference calls.
- On Wednesday night we will continue to meet in the parking lot or online at this time
