PHASE TWO

In the Badger Bounce Back plan, the shift from Phase One to Phase Two is based on a reevaluation of the situation using the original criteria.

Atonement's Procedures:

• Worship will be offered via outdoor services or 2 different indoor service times, as attendance dictates. A streaming service will still be offered. Fore committee to work with Pastor on time slots for the 2 worship services and the Sundays in which it is held outdoors.

When worshipping in church...

Will start with two services-

Each team/committee will self-regulate with guidelines set forth.

- It is highly encouraged to wear cloth face masks while at church, as is recommended in public spaces.
- Communion not yet offered
- No singing in the sanctuary while the congregation is gathered. Music is pre-recorded.
- No passing of the peace
- No bulletins
- No hymnals
- Offering is collected in the Narthex
- Distancing: Have people spread out in sanctuary space with one family unit per pew; keep empty pews between families. IF worshipping outdoors keep family units intact with distance between the next family unit.
- Fellowship offered online.
- Continue encouraging people to leave the building rather than mingling.

LEAVE DOORS OPEN-FRONT DOORS OPEN-GREETERS-CUT OFF HALLWAY FROM KITCHEN

- Small Group Bible studies may continue using social distancing and wearing masks. Group size is increased from 10 to 50.
- Confirmation meets in person
- Sunday School meets in person.

- Prayer ground will be unavailable.
- When using nursery please only one family at a time, library will be open for families.
- Mission trips discouraged
- Church still not open to the public
- Church Office back to regular hours, continue detailed cleaning procedures. High Risk staff and members are encouraged not yet to be in the church office.
- Continue with phase 1 cleaning procedures.
