Jesus—Nothing More, Nothing Less Discussion/Study Guide for Colossians 1:1-2

- 1. After listening to Pastor Phil's reflections on Colossians 1:1-2, what initial thoughts come to your mind that encourage or challenge you in your walk with Jesus?
- 2. Reread Colossians 1:1-2 together. You, or someone else in the group, put into your own words who this letter is from; who this letter is to; and what this letter is about. Be creative.
- 3. Who is included with Paul in the writing of this letter? Why is he important to Paul? Do you have such a person in your life? If so, who? If not, who could you begin to cultivate this kind of relationship with?
- 4. What 2 words does Paul use to describe the brothers (and sisters) in Colossae? How do Col. 1:23 and 2:6-7 help us understand what it means to be described as one of these brothers or sisters in Christ?
- 5. What can we learn about God from Paul's greeting in verse 2?
- 6. How would you define the grace of God? How would you define the peace of God?
- 7. Where do you need to experience God's grace and/or peace in your life today? Is there anything standing in the way of you experiencing that today?
- 8. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His grace and peace, asking for it in those specific areas which you've identified.
