Important Announcement for Sunday, June 28, 2020

With great concern for the well-being of our church family, your leaders have decided to **CANCEL** services at the building for Sunday, June 28.

After running a fever on Monday evening, Jim Holt received results Wednesday afternoon that he tested positive for COVID-19. Jim seems to be doing well now, and we pray that he continues to improve.

We want to make the church aware that Jim was at both services this past Sunday, June 21. It would be difficult to account for all the members who might possibly have been exposed. If you were in contact with Jim, we encourage you to self-quarantine and watch for symptoms of the virus.

We will provide online worship resources Sunday, June 28 on our website and church Facebook page. Communion supplies will be available to pick up in Room 109. Use the office entrance on the south side of the building. Wes will be at the building on Sunday from 9-10am if you need to pick up communion supplies.

We will still have the *"Night of 100 Casseroles"* Thursday, June 25, but we ask all volunteers to wear face masks and gloves (*provided if you don't have them*). If you feel you may have been exposed to the virus or are experiencing symptoms, we ask that you not participate this month. We will practice social distancing and extreme caution in serving all who drive through to pick up a dinner.

Our current plan is to resume our worship services at the building Sunday, July 5. As we look forward to being back together again, let's consider how we can do even more to continue safe practices that will protect our most vulnerable members from this virus.

BASIC NEEDS RE-OPENING PLANS

Basic Needs has now returned to their usual location. Food is being distributed at the Basic Needs Store using a 6ft distancing method. This method of food distribution will continue until the 6ft separation restraints are lifted. Only 1 person per family will be allowed in the pantry (with the exception of handicapped individuals needing assistance). However, **clothing will not be distributed at the Store**, our clients will be able to get needed clothing and household items at the Family Center after receiving a ticket to do so from the store beginning July 2. **The Basic Needs Workroom has reopened**. **Food distribution from the Store began June 18; and Clothing Distribution from the Family Center begins July 2.** This method of distribution will continue until we no longer need to practice social distancing. **BASIC NEEDS NEEDS VOLUNTEERS!**
