Council Notes:

1. There will be a congregational meeting on Sunday morning, July 19, 2020 immediately following the morning service for the purpose of approving Restated Articles of Incorporation and approving budget amendments for the 2020 budget in support of the parking lot replacement and support for Christian Education. Copies of all materials are available on-line at <https://rudyardcrc.org/church-council> and in the narthex. Absentee ballots can be dropped off to a council member prior to the meeting. Voting will be on three separate proposals.
 1. Approval of the Restated Articles of Incorporation.
 2. Approval of the parking lot budget amendments (increase of \$20,000 to facilities maintenance budget and establishing a parking lot fund to receive the donations towards the remaining estimated \$35,000 cost of the project.
 3. Approval of the Christian Education budget amendment (\$7000 for direct support to the North Rudyard Christian School, \$3000 for a need based Christian Education Scholarship Fund)
2. The August 30 offering will be for missions
3. Council has decided to continue suspension of the evening service and will revisit the issue again this fall.
4. Pastor John will be on vacation July 6-12 and July 23-August 5, Pastor Joe Sereno will be filling in on July 12, 26 and August 2.
5. We will not be holding a 4th of July picnic this year. Instead, we are planning a workbee at the church picnic grounds for Friday July 17 beginning around 12:00 pm with a cookout/bonfire in the evening. There are lots of downed branches and other debris to clean up and help of all kinds is needed, including foremen and women.
