Bulletin Announcement for Sunday, July 5, 2020

Dear Church Family,

We will be meeting at the building this Sunday morning, July 5, with two services, the first at 9:00 and the second at 10:45. I had planned for the Sunday of the Independence Day weekend to be a special prayer service for our nation using Elders and Deacons for prayers and readings; but with our current rapid rise of the Corona Virus, I think what I had planned has too many moving bodies for the health safety we need to implement this Sunday. I have changed the worship plan to simplify the worship services. While still emphasizing prayer and concern for our nation during this holiday, I plan to make it a service that stays with our usual number involved. Wes will welcome the church and introduce the communion service. Taylor will share the Scripture Readings and Prayer. Rusty will be leading a time of prayer for our nation in song and prayer. One of the Elders will lead the Shepherd's Prayer in each service, and I will be preaching on the topic of "Strength of God for Our Nation." We will target a date in the future for a special prayer service led by our Elders and Deacons.

We love being together for worship to God. We all felt an emptiness from not being able to meet last Sunday, but due to the potential of wide virus exposure it was wise not to meet. We approach this Sunday with continued concern and caution. You are encouraged to worship at home if you are experiencing any possible symptoms, or if you have recently been exposed to the Corona Virus. We are going to be very vigilant to clean and sanitize our building and encourage members to practice social distancing in the lobby and in keeping with the designated seating, use hand sanitizer, and refrain from hugging and shaking hands or lingering in the lobby after services this Sunday. We encourage those who are at risk to use the designated seating area at the rear of the west side of the building. We will dismiss by rows beginning with the at-risk seating section. You are encouraged to wear a face covering when in locations necessitating face to face encounters. I personally, for your safety and to set a good example, plan to wear a mask in the lobby area (taking it off to preach). I don't like wearing a mask, and don't like you not being able to see me smile at you, and I don't like not being able to see you smile back; but we do this because we love each other and it allows us to protect each other while still meeting together.

It has been said so many times that it may have lost the seriousness of its meaning, but we must join together in these practices of care for one another "out of an abundance of caution," or the virus will spread throughout our church family where some of our brothers and sisters are vulnerable to becoming gravely ill and even dying.
