• SCRIPTURE

John 1:1-18 (New International Version)

¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. ⁶ There was a man sent from God whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. 8 He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light. 9 The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. ¹⁰ He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. ¹¹ He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. 12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. 14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. 15 (John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the one I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.'") 16 Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. ¹⁷ For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. 18 No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.

Mark 14:32-36 (New International Version)

³² They went to a place called Gethsemane, and Jesus said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray." ³³ He took Peter, James and John along with him, and he began to be deeply distressed and troubled. ³⁴ "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death," he said to them. "Stay here and keep watch." ³⁵ Going a little farther, he fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him. ³⁶ "Abba, Father," he said, "everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

• **DISCUSSION** 15-20 minutes

(Use these questions to connect with your group, reflect, and apply this week's message to life. You don't have to get through every question, just choose the ones that connect with your group.)

- o How is everyone doing? What have been the highs and lows of your week?
- What about today's message inspired or resonated with you? What challenged or confused you?
- Do you tend to emphasize more Jesus' humanity or Jesus' divinity? Why do you think this is and what has been the effect on your walk with God?
- Why is it important to hold on to the truth that Jesus is both fully God and fully Human? Do you find this challenging? Where have you seen opposition?
- Do you find it easy or hard to believe that Jesus empathizes with your humanity?
 What difference does it make to know this?
- o How has Beautiful Outlaw impacted you so far? Some key insights?

• PRAYER 10-15 minutes

 Use the "P.R.A.Y." model to pray together. One leader can facilitate this prayer time by talking through each portion and giving the group space to pray. **Pause** – Be still, rest in silence, focus yourself on God's presence – in your heart you can say a simple phrase like, "My God and my all"

Rejoice – Lift up your praises for God's presence and God's blessings

Ask – Pray for the various requests mentioned as a group

Yield (or "Yes" for kids) – Surrender to God's power and God's will, yield to God's presence, contemplate his glory

The Lord's Prayer

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. HVAC System

Two large and aged HVAC units in the church have recently failed. We need to replace them with new and updated systems that meet modern codes. These units affect important areas of the church even in lockdown: the childcare classrooms below the sanctuary, the upstairs nursery and the kitchen. Until these repairs are made, we have relocated classes and put in window units in the nursery, but we are looking to replace the system and get back to full functioning as soon as possible! Further, other HVAC units of the church are aging and in need of replacement in the near future. In order to replace these two broken units, we have set a goal to raise \$25,000. this summer. This is a bold goal any time, particularly at *this* time. But this is what's needed to keep our facilities functioning to serve the daily ministry of the church. We have seen God provide in amazing ways in the past and we are confident He will meet this need through his people. Would you pray about going above and beyond to help us with this cause?
