Hi my Immanuel Friends,

Are you glad it is summer time and you get to play outside in the warm weather? Me too! What have you been doing? Have you been spending your days swimming in a pool or playing in the sprinkler? Have mommy or daddy been taking you to the beach? Maybe you have been hanging out in your yard in a kiddie pool. They all sound like fun things to do when it is nice outside. One thing I like to do with my family when it is nice outside is go kayaking! We have so much fun.



This is a picture of my family kayaking a couple of years ago. It is so relaxing on the water. When we go kayaking my son loves to go fishing. He only catches a couple of fish and he puts them right back in the water. Our bible story today is about some men who were fishing, but they couldn't seem to catch any fish on their own. They needed somebody's help. I wonder who helped them catch fish. Let's read the story to find out. Our story comes from the book of John in the Bible. What is the Bible? Yes, it is God's special book. Now I want you to pretend you have a fishing net as we read the story. Every time you hear the word fish or the word fishing, I want you to pretend to try to catch a fish. We will practice it first. I like FISHING. Did you pretend to throw out your net and catch fish? Good listening!!

Peter decided to go out and go fishing and he said to two of his friends, "I am going out to fish." His friends said, "We will go fishing with you." So they all got into Peter's boat and went out to fish on the lake. They rowed the boat out into the water, threw the nets over the side and waited for the fish to swim into the nets. (Are you remembering to pretend to catch fish?) Peter and his friends kept fishing all night long, but they did not catch any fish. No fish..how do you think the men felt. Yes, I bet they felt sad.



Early in the morning, a man stood on the shore and called out to Peter, "Friends, did you catch any fish?" Peter and his friends shook their heads and said "No". The man then told Peter and his friends to throw the net on the right side of the boat and they would catch some fish. They did what the man said, and right away their net filled up with fish!! The net was so filled up with fish that Peter and his friends couldn't even pull it back into the boat.



One of Peter's friends looked at the man on the shore and said, 'It is Jesus!' Right away Peter jumped out of the boat and started swimming towards Jesus. The rest of the friends stayed in the boat and rowed back to the shore dragging the net of fish with them. When they got to the shore Jesus was waiting and asked the men to have breakfast with Him. What do you think they ate for breakfast? FISH!!

WOW! Jesus can do anything!!! When the men were fishing on their own, they caught no fish. But Jesus helped them fill their nets with fish. Isn't that amazing! I want to sing a song with you. (moms and dads, sing it to the tune of London Bridge or make up your own tune) Ready:

Jesus can do anything! Yes He can! Yes He can! Jesus can do anything, He's our mighty Savior.

Jesus can do miracles! Yes He can! Yes He can! Jesus can do miracles He's our nighty Savior!

Jesus can do anything and because He is our friend, He will help us when we need Him to. There is a bible verse in the Book of Philippians (4:13) that says, "I can do all things through Christ, who gives me strength." Jesus Christ is with you always and will help You with anything. YAY for Jesus being our friend and helping us!

Let's pray together:

Dear Jesus, thank you for being our friend. Thank you for loving us. Help us to remember that if we are feeling alone, afraid, or sad, all we have to do is ask for Your help, and you will help us be strong. In Jesus' Name Amen.

Good morning Immanuel kids,

Last week we talked a bit about the fruit of the Spirit and what that means. Remember, the Holy Spirit is God living with us and in us. The Holy Spirit helps us change our thoughts and actions to be more like Jesus. I want to read our verse from last week. Galatians 5: 22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." Today we are going to look at the first fruit, which is love, and what that fruit will look like in our lives. But before we do that, we need to know a little more about love.

Let me ask you a couple of silly questions first. Here is a picture of a house.



Could the builders have started with the roof first? Why not? Okay, you are right. You need to start with the foundation and build up. Now, look at the cake picture.



(I personally am drooling right now and want to lick the frosting off the cake!) Anyway...

Could the baker have started by putting the frosting on first? Why not? Okay, right again! You have to start at the bottom and build up. I won't give you any more silly questions. My next question you may be able to answer, but it might be difficult to explain your answer to me? Can people truly love one another if they don't know God? That may be a bit trickier to explain. Why don't we read 1 John 4:7-11 to get our answer.

"Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."

When people think about love, they often start with how to love others. The Bible does talk a lot about loving others, but in the verse we just read, God makes it clear that love begins with Him. God is love. We can't truly love others until we start with the foundation of love, which is God.

Read the verse again and find two ways that God demonstrates His love for us. Why don't you circle them before we move on.

The two ways are:

- 1. God sent His only Son that we might live through Him.
- 2. God sent His Son as a sacrifice for our sins.

As you can see, this is where love starts. God is love and He loved first. Apart from Him, it is impossible to show true love to others. This verse shows us that love is not just something we say, it is what we DO. Jesus showed His great love for us by dying for us. We can show love to one another by putting others first and thinking of them more than ourselves, loving them like Christ loved us.

Well now that we know that God is love, what will His love look like in our lives as we follow the Spirit's leading? Let's read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 to help us figure it out.

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails."

Now read it again and this time I want you to circle, underline, or highlight each description of what love is or what love isn't. Are you doing it or are you just waiting for me to list the answers? Ok good, you are at least making an attempt to do it on your own. Or maybe you figured out that the words in BOLD letters are the answers to what I just asked. There are many descriptions listed there!! Love is not just saying, "I love you, or I love that toy, or I love soccer." It is so much more!

I am going to give you a scenario and I want you to tell me how someone living with the Spirit in them should act based on the love description from First Corinthians.

A girl in your class has no friends because she is mean to everyone. She even pushed you one day and told you to get out of her way!

How should you treat this girl? Be kind to her no matter how she treats you and don't be rude back. Try not to be angry with her. Those are good responses. Now, how do you think someone who is not living in the Spirit might treat this girl? Push her back and say mean things to her. Maybe spread lies about her. Again, good answers.

Let's look at another scenario - your mom asked you to do something that you don't want to do and you don't think she is being fair. How might someone without the Spirit living in them respond? Complain, whine, stomp your feet and tell the mom "no" and refuse to do what she asked.. If you have the Spirit living in you, what should your response be? Listen to your mom and do as she says even if you don't want to- good answers!

Good job thinking about these things!! There are many ways we can show love to the people around us. Love is a command from God, a choice we make daily, and a fruit produced by the Holy Spirit as we seek to know Him and abide in Him. When Jesus was on earth, He told us that each of us has a job to do. That job is to tell others about God's love for them. One of the best ways we can do that is to show love by our actions to those around us.

I have a homework assignment for you. No whining...you are done with school for the summer and a little homework won't hurt you! Your assignment is to write down ways you can show love to others in your life this week and then follow through on what you write. Maybe it could be to you mom or dad, a brother or sister, a neighbor, your mail carrier, etc. Remember 1 John tells us to love with our actions!! I know you can do this!


